SERMON

Sent to the Harvest at Eastertime

1. The Good News of the Kingdom (vs. 35).

"Jesus went through all the towns and villages, teaching in their synagogues, proclaiming the good news of the kingdom and healing every disease and sickness" (Matthew 9:35).

2. The Needs of the World Around Us (vs. 36).

"When he saw the crowds, he had compassion on them, because they were harassed and helpless, like sheep without a shepherd" (Matthew 9:36).

3. The Need for a Saviour (vs. 37-38).

Then he said to his disciples, "The harvest is plentiful, but the workers are few. Ask the Lord of the harvest, therefore, to send out workers into his harvest field." (Matthew 9:37-38).

From the National Church Life Survey:

In December 2022, the Australian Community Survey (2022 ACS) asked Australians if they would go to church this Easter if a close friend or family member invited them. Four in 10 (42%) Australians would go to an Easter service if invited. A further 19% of those surveyed said they were unsure. Three in ten (29%) Australians said they would not go to an Easter service if invited, and 10% said they have no close friends or family who attend church. While up to 42% of Australians might go to church at Easter if invited, the actual numbers of Aussies attending Easter services over the last three years are much lower: at just 17%.

"People are more receptive to attending church at a significant time like Easter- so go ahead and invite them." says NCLS Research Director, Dr Ruth Powell.
