Welcome to St Philip's Church Easter Day Sunday 31st March 2024

We'd love to see you here again every Sunday. Our regular service times are 8:30am, 10:30am and 6pm.

Does it surprise you to learn that God has 'hands'?

I don't mean hands with flesh and knuckles and blood and fingernails. God is spirit, after all. In the Bible, his hand redeems, guides, upholds, judges and acts.

In other words, God does things in his world.

This is good news.

But the Christian Gospel goes one step further: the claim of the New Testament is that God took on flesh in the person of Jesus Christ. In other words, God chose hands. And hands with flesh and knuckles and blood and fingernails. This is called 'incarnation'; God taking on flesh.

And at Easter we say that those hands were pierced with nails; that Jesus willingly chose a cross, rather than a sword. He chose to be bullied, rather than to bully. He chose love, rather than indifference. And that this action changed the course of history. And it saves lives too.

At Church Hill this Easter our hope is that you will see how his hand might shape your life. It will be surprising. And joyful.
